Pursuant to Section 19.21(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes and Section 1.09 of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code, this is notice to you that the City Attorney's Office intends to destroy *various folders of Personnel files pertaining to Workers Compensation, Unemployment Compensation, and Grievance/Arbitration*. None of the records involved are required to be preserved by ordinance or resolution of the Common Council.

We are required to provide sixty (60) days written notice of our intent to the Common Council. The Wisconsin Historical Society has waived notification of these categories of records.
