Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on June 25, 2013, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That Albert Hernandez was properly served a copy of the summons and complaint, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ar);
2. That Albert Hernandez admitted to the allegations in the complaint, and the allegations are true;
3. That the conduct of Albert Hernandez described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b).
4. That in particular, Albert Hernandez's three operating while intoxicated convictions are contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b).

CONCLUSION OF LAW:


1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to revoke and not renew the Class "I" Operator's License of Albert Hernandez.

RECOMMENDATION:

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class "T" Operator's License of Albert Hernandez be revoked and not renewed.
