


5. That on October 6, 1999; August 23, 2001; and January 8, 2012, Margaret Finley did operate a motor vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant, contrary to section 346.63(1)(A), Wis. Stats., and was subsequently convicted of said offenses.
6. That the conduct of Margaret Finley described in paragraph 5 substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b), so as to disqualify Margaret Finley from obtaining, keeping, or renewing a Class "I" Operator's License.

WHEREFORE, Michael J. Czaplewski requests that Margaret Finley be summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Operator's License issued to Margaret Finley should be suspended, revoked or not renewed.
