The following is a synopsis of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service for the month of April 2010.

Police report incidents involving licensed businesses:

Incident reports:

On the above date and time officers responded to Shawna's Pub and Grill for a report of a male party being assaulted by three other parties in the men's room.
