




6. That according to the records of the West Allis City Clerk's office, the clerk notified Thomas Doyle in writing a second time that he was required to appear at the September 1, 2009 License and Health meeting.
7. That Doyle did not appear at the September 1, 2009 meeting and did not contact the clerk's office.
8. That the conduct of Doyle Foodservices, Inc., by registered agent Thomas Doyle, substantially relates to the licensed activity contrary to West Allis Revised Municipal Ordinance 9.02 (12)(b) and is grounds for non-renewal, suspension, or revocation of its Class B Tavern license.

WHEREFORE, Michael J. Czaplewski, requests that Doyle Foodservices, Inc., c/o Thomas Doyle, be summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Class B Tavern License of Doyle's Foodservices, Inc. should be revoked, suspended, or not renewed.
