License and Health Committee,

On Monday 12/20/04, I was made aware that a neighbor of The Rock Shop had a concern regarding a telephone message he had received from the license holder, Brian Malec.

I contacted this person and was told that he had called police to complain of loud noise on Saturday 12/18/04. After police had left, the music was toned down.

However, he then received a call from Brian Malec and a message was left on the answering machine. The message was not threatening in any way but did concern the complainant due to the tone.

I listened to the message that was played to me over the telephone and did make a copy that can be available to any committee member upon request. In the message, Malec says that he is trying to keep the noise down and accuses the complainant of being one of the reasons he is losing the business and "thousands of dollars". Malec makes reference to Wayne Pullach in a derogatory manner, as a "Fuching liar" and says that the complainant will not be happy when the new tenant takes over. Malec says that he has a license to have live music in the tavern and that is what he is going to do.

Malec refers to the fact that there is only two weeks left before his business is closed during the message. I am forwarding this information to you as I felt it was important for you to be aware of, as Malec will want to use his license in another location and his confronting neighbors who complain in a way that makes them uneasy or complain further would be of interest to the committee.

Reference: Conversation with Brian Malec

License and Health Committee,

In response to the incident involving Malec as described in my letter of 12/21/04 and addressed during the meeting on 12/21/04, Brian Malec came to the police station to speak with me at 5:30 PM this date.

I reviewed the contents of the telephone message he had left for a neighbor of The Rock Shop and asked specifically what he was referring to when he made statements about the neighbor not being happy when the new operator moves in. Malec said that he was just blowing smoke when saying that and that he doesn't know Mario or have any information as to future problems that may occur.

I expressed concern that a license holder in the city would leave such messages or speak to neighbors in a manner that would make them feel uncomfortable. Malec agreed that he should not have left the message and said that he has been stressed because of problems with Wayne and losing his business at the current location.

I reviewed my role and efforts that should be taken to reduce assaults and other problems at taverns for Malec to keep in mind when he does find another location. Malec was receptive to the ideas presented. Malec said that he would contact me when he finds a new location and would like to get together to share ideas regarding how to best prevent problems.

Malec agreed that he would work with neighbors of any location he finds and will control his stress so that he does not have problems with neighbors in the future.

The audiotape of the message left by Malec will be maintained in my files and can be accessed for any committee member if requested.
