Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on June 25, 2013, the Committee finds:

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. That John Cissa was properly served a copy of the summons and complaint, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ar);
2. That John Cissa admitted to the allegations in the complaint, and the allegations are true;
3. That the conduct of John Cissa described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b);
4. That in particular, John Cissa's four operating while intoxicated convictions are contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b).

**CONCLUSION OF LAW:**

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to revoke and not renew the Class "I" Operator's License of John Cissa.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class "I" Operator's License of John Cissa be revoked and not renewed.
