RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INCREASE IN 2026 TO THE STORM WATER MANAGEMENT CHARGES

WHEREAS, Section 1.07(4)(e) authorizes the Common Council to revise storm water management system user charges, as necessary, to insure that the system generates adequate revenues to fund the management of the City's storm water system, including the involvement and reinvestment in and the maintenance and improvement of new and existing infrastructures, and other improvements to the system that will reduce flooding and urban non-point source pollution in storm water run-off consistent with federal and state regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the 2026 budget requires an increase in the storm water management system user charge to fund the cost of the storm water system, including investment and reinvestment in new and existing infrastructure.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that there be a \$3.21 increase in the storm water management user charge, from \$22.02 per ERU to \$25.23 per ERU, to be effective January 1, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water Systems Manager is directed to notify each user of the Sanitary Sewer Collection System of the aforesaid rate increase as provided in Section 1.07(4)(f) of the Revised Municipal Code.
