They left at the end of the work day indicating they would return to complete the work. They did not fence the site or clean up the debris created. The Forestry Dept. failed to return. When Barbara Fabiszak attempted to walk down her drive way she tripped on a piece of construction debris, causing her to fall, breaking her pelvis, and causing numerous strains + sprains. She has had numerous hospital visits and stays in an inpatient physical therapy facility. She has also participated in home physical therapy. Treatment is ongoing. In addition to the physical injuries, the construction

activities removed all the gravel, leaving ruts and uneven surfaces. Trees that would have mitigated the amount and force of water flowing through the construction site and adjacent property ^{were removed.} As a result, the excessive water puts a strain on basement sump pumps, causing the motor to burn out and flood the basement.

Costs for medical treatment continue to be incurred. There will be costs for engineering evaluation and assessment by the Department of Natural Resources to determine appropriate mitigation and repair measures.
