D. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

2. [26-0005](#) Appeal by Ezequiel Meza of the Dangerous Dog Order issued on December 10th, 2025 for Polo at 5515 W. Rogers St. (AARB-36)

Ald. Weigel moved to modify the dangerous dog order for Polo to require only the following conditions:

1. Polo must wear a collar with identification whenever outside the house.
2. The unsecured portion of the fence around Mr. Meza's property must be secured within 30 days.
3. Dangerous animal signage must be posted at Mr. Meza's property within 10 days.
4. Mr. Meza must pay any expenses as a result of the incident.
5. Polo must be sterilized and microchipped within 1 year.
6. Polo must be licensed and registered within 10 days.

If all the conditions are met and no other incidents occur for one year following the order, Polo's dangerous dog designation will expire; if any of the conditions are not met, the dangerous dog designation will become permanent.
