SB230 EXEMPT EXPENDITURES MADE IN RESPONSE TO A DISASTER

FROM LEVY LIMITS AND ERP

2. REVIEW OF REFERRED LEGISLATION

AB161 REIMBURSEMENT FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY DOGS AND THE USE OF FUNDS DERIVED FROM THE LICENSING OF DOGS OPPOSE, because the bill could cost the City, County, and/or MADACC significant amounts of money for dog claims.

SB226 RECODIFICATION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT LAW Hold for comments from Steve Hook.

AB269/ CAUSING INJURY TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHILE RESISTING OR OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER OR WHILE ATTEMPTING TO FLEE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FAVOR

CAMPAIGN FINANCING, DESIGNATIONS FOR THE WIS.
