Dear Mayor Bell:

I am writing to inform you of some changes we have made and will be making to our channel line-ups. Effective June 1, 2003, iNDEMAND 1 on channel 74 will no longer be available on analog and will be exclusively available on Digital channel 801; iNDEMAND 4 on channel 77 will no longer be available on analog and will be exclusively available on Digital channel 804; and iNDEMAND 5 on channel 78 will no longer be available on analog and will be exclusively available on Digital channel 805. A digital converter will be required to order Pay-per-view. The digital converter is the same price as the analog converter. If customers would like to order a digital converter, they can call 1-866-489-2227 to schedule an installation. We are notifying our customers of this change via bill message.

On April 2, 2003, Time Warner Cable added our newest iCONTROL channel, "Answers on Demand" on Digital Cable channel 1999. All digital cable customers will have access to this channel at no cost. Answers on Demand shows customers how to get the most out of digital cable.

Through interactive video tutorials, customers can get the information they need regarding how to use their Remote Control, how to find the shows they want quickly using the Program Guide, how to set up Parental Control, watch movies with iControl and more.
