Associated Bank, N.A. v. Cesar Romero Arias, et al.

Foreclosure - Milwaukee County Case No. 17-CV-000359

Dear Council Members:

The enclosed summons and complaint has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05(8) of the Revised Municipal Code. After examining the facts of the complaint and the applicable law, my recommendation is to place this summons and complaint on file.

In January 2018, Associated Bank foreclosed on property owned by Cesar Romero Arias and Jenny De La Cruz located at 1708 South 72nd Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Due to the City having a lien on the property, the City was named a Defendant in the circuit court action so Associated Bank could properly foreclose out the lien. On December 3, 2018, the circuit court action concluded with the judge signing an order confirming the sheriff's sale of the property, thereby extinguishing the City's lien on the property. With the City's lien already being paid in full, however, the circuit court action had no effect on the City's interests.

Based upon the above, this matter should be placed on file.
