Resolution Accepting a Storm Sewer Easement from School District of West Allis-West Milwaukee, et al. for the Property at 87** West Lincoln Avenue (South Parking Lot).

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands and interests shown and described on Engineering Drawing File No. Y-1154, dated May 16th, 2006, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, have requested the City of West Allis ("City") to proceed with the installation of a storm sewer (the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, the City is willing to proceed with the Project provided the School District of West Allis-West Milwaukee, et al. agrees to Mutual Benefit for compensation of the necessary lands and interests for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City agrees to renovate and repave both commercial driveways to the school's parking lot; and,

WHEREAS, there would be no displacement of persons or property as a result of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis as follows:

- 1. That the City Attorney be and is hereby authorized and directed to acquire, by Mutual Benefit, the lands and interests set forth in Exhibit "A" from the School District of West Allis-West Milwaukee, et al. and from any and all other persons or entities which may have an interest in said lands.
- 2. That it hereby declares its intent not to proceed with acquisition of the aforesaid lands and interests under the eminent domain procedures of Chapter 32 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- 3. That the Mayor and the City Administrative Officer, Clerk/Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Storm Sewer Easement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference, on behalf of the City, as adopted and approved.



EASEMENT

Storm Sewer Easement granted by SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WEST ALLIS-WEST MILWAUKEE, ET AL., hereinafter referred to as the "Grantor" to the CITY OF WEST ALLIS, a Wisconsin Municipal Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grantee desires to construct, maintain, repair, rebuild, and operate a storm sewer main and appurtenances through and along the premises hereinafter described and owned by the Grantor; and,

WHEREAS, the Grantor is willing to grant an easement therefore on the terms and conditions hereof and the maintenance and operation of said storm sewer main and appurtenances by the Grantee.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of compensation by Mutual Benefit, the Grantor for itself, its heirs, successors and assigns do hereby grant unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement over, under, through, along, and upon the lands described as follows:

A strip of land, being part of Lot 2 of Assessor's Plat No. 262, Block 2, located in the Northwest ¼ of Section 9, Township 6 North, Range 21 East, in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Parcel 1, Certified Survey Map No. 2012; thence Westerly, 270.14 feet, along the South right-of-way line of West Lincoln Avenue to the Point of Beginning of this description; thence Southerly, 146.73 feet, parallel with east line of said Lot 2; thence Westerly, 54.55 feet, at right angle to said line to the west line of said Lot 2; thence Northerly 20.00 feet; thence Easterly, 34.55 feet; thence Northerly, 126.31 feet, to the South right-of-way line of West Lincoln Avenue; thence Easterly, 20.00 feet along said south line to the Point of Beginning.

Said land contains 0.0831 acres, more or less.

In granting this Easement, Grantor reserves to itself, its successors and assigns the right to make use of the surface of the easement area, as will not injure the aforesaid storm sewer main and appurtenances or prevent ingress or egress thereto for the purposes of constructing, operating, repairing, maintaining, improving, or rebuilding the same; provided, however, that no building or structure of any kind shall be erected upon any part of said Easement without prior permit from the Grantee.

This grant of Easement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs.


