Ed Lisinski, Director of Building Inspections & Neighborhood Services, commented on the electrical contractor. Sally Nusslock, Health Commissioner, was asked if Health had inspected yet. Lajsic commented the goal is to have Mr. Mellantine open on August 1, 2017 and that it would be fine if Mr. Mellantine wanted or needed to be open limited days or hours because of staffing.
