**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEASTERN
WISCONSIN WATERSHEDS TRUST, INC. (SWEETWATER) FOR IDENTIFYING
AND STOPPING BACTERIAL CONTAMINATION FROM LEAKING
WASTEWATER PIPES**

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis recognizes the importance of identifying and removing bacterial contamination from leaking wastewater pipes entering our storm sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, Sweetwater has partnered with the UW-Milwaukee School of Freshwater Sciences to test for bacteria in a manner which will reduce the cost of testing, standardize the process of testing with other nearby municipalities, and be in accordance with the City's Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Storm Sewer Permit; and,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the City Engineer is directed and authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust, Inc. (Sweetwater) for the standardized regional process to assist municipalities in identifying and stopping bacterial contamination from leaking wastewater pipes.
