Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on May 31, 2011, the Committee finds:

## **FINDINGS OF FACT:**

- 1. That Gregory Steffek was served a copy of the summons and complaint:
- 2. That Gregory Steffek, by Attorney Joseph Redding, stipulated to the complaint and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
- 3. That the conduct of Gregory Steffek d/b/a Mugshotz described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b);

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to suspend the "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License of Gregory Steffek d/b/a Mugshotz for 10 days, beginning on 2:00 a.m. on June 13, 2011 and ending on June 23, 2011 at 2:00 a.m.

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor and Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License of Gregory Steffek d/b/a Mugshotz be suspended for 10 days, beginning on 2:00 a.m. on June 13, 2011 and ending on June 23, 2011 at 2:00 a.m.
