Communication from the Director of Public Works/City Engineer regarding status of upcoming water rate increase by the Wisconsin

Public Service order.

A number of months ago, the Common Council authorized the Water Utility to petition the Wisconsin Public Service Commission (WPSC) for a water rate increase. We are now at the stage where a public hearing will be conducted by WPSC on July 14<sup>th</sup>.

At this time, we are projecting an increase of about \$4.44 per quarter for the average household (using 19 ccf or 1,900 cubic feet) or about 6.7%. Main reason for the increase is our painting of the 84<sup>th</sup> Street water tower and water main replacement projects. Keep in mind that for City budgeting we budget the money first and then do the project. With WPSC is the exact opposite, we do the project and then set the water rates to pay for it.

In all, we feel it's a small increase for the average household in order to continue with much needed water main replacement.
