Legacy has been providing recycling service for the City for quite some time and IT is very pleased with them. We met with them twice and are confident that they will do a good job.

I didn't want to get into the electronic waste recycling business because it takes extra time and we don't have the room at the Yard, but we will now have to make time and make the room.

During the trial period, Legacy's \$20 fee for TV will just be passed along to the users without any City mark up. All other electronics are free of charge.
