SUMMARY

P.O. Mathy reports...On 11/21/13 at approximately 0140hrs, I responded to the Happy Tap bar, 6801 W. Beloit Rd., for a theft call. Contact was made with the bartender, Stephanie M. Couillard F/W 11/09/87, who stated between 1800 and 0130hrs, an electronic gaming machine compromised. Couillard said an unknown amount of cash was taken from the machine and the locking mechanism was compromised. Couillard believed the following four described individuals may be involved, described as a M/W, approximately 50-60 years old, 5'11, skinny build, a F/B approximately 40 years old, 5'5, 150lbs, a B/M approximately 40-50 years old, 6'0, and a medium build, as well as a W/F approximately 40 years old, shoulder length blond hair, 5'6, and 150lbs. Couillard said all the suspects described were surrounding the matching between 2200 and 2300hrs, however, the theft was not observed.

NARRATIVE**INITIAL CALL****Officer Mathy reports...**

On 11/21/13 at approximately 0140hrs, I responded the Happy Tap bar, 6801 W. Beloit Rd., for a theft call. Dispatch advised the reported suspects had left on foot at approximately 2300hrs.

STATEMENT- KIM M. CAZE (VICTIM)

Upon arrival I made contact with the vicitm, Kim M. Caze F/W 11/14/65, who is the owner of the Happy Tap bar. I asked Caze to explain what occurred. Caze said the bartender, Stephanie M. Couillard F/W 11/09/87, informed her that an electronic game machine was broken into during the course of her shift. Caze said she was not present when the reported suspects were utilizing the machine, however, Caze said she last observed the gaming machine in normal condition at approximately 1800hrs on 11/20/13. Caze informed me that the locking mechanism was broken and that an unknown amount of cash was taken. Caze estimated the loss of cash between \$40 and \$200. Caze said she would be able to provide an exact amount of cash taken when she inquires the with electronic gaming machine provider, Reds Novelty Ltd., whom she leases the machine from.

I asked Caze if she had video surveillance in her bar and she said she did not. I asked Caze if she knew of anybody that may want to steal from her. Caze said she did not know of anyone specific, however, she said she has been given information about individuals stealing from gaming machines through the Tavern League of Wisconsin. Couillard informed Caze that she observed four individuals that she

believes were involved. I asked Caze if she could estimate the amount of damage to the gaming machine and she said she did not know and would have to contact Reds Novelty.

Caze informed me that she heard two other bars have recently had thefts from the gaming machines, which the offenders used a similar method of breaking the locking mechanism. Caze said the two establishments were Milwaukee Nights Pub, located at 3830 W. National Ave. and The Sly Fox bar, located at 1401 S. 38 St.

Caze informed me the pad lock on the machine was broken and the attachment for the locking mechanism, which originates inside the gaming machine, appeared to be loose and may need replacing. Caze did not know how much it would cost to repair the machine.

I asked Caze if the machine had a specific name and she said it did not. Caze did not have any other specific information in regards to the make or model of the machine that was damaged.

LACK OF CONSENT

Caze did not give anyone permission to damage her leased electronic gaming machine or steal the money contained inside it.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS/ DAMAGED PROPERTY

While on scene I observed the damaged locking pad lock. The lock bar on the pad lock was not cut, however, it appeared an object was used to compromised the interior of the lock housing through the key hole. Additionally, I observed the metal frame bar, which attaches the pad lock to the interior of the gaming machine was loosed and appeared to have had been altered from its original state.

STATEMENT- STEPHANIE M. COUILLARD (WITNESS)

I asked Couillard to explain what she observed. Couillard said at approximately 2200hrs, four individuals came into the bar as a group and were huddled around the gaming machine that was broken in to. Couillard said she has not seen these four individuals in the past, however, she thought thier behavior was unusual to have all of the surrounding the machine. Couillard supplied the following description of the four individuals she observed.

Suspect Description

1. Couillard said the first suspect, a black male, was actually playing the game while the other male and two females were standing close to him. Couillard described the black male as approximately 40-50 years old, 6'0, medium build, with

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a dark skin tone. Couillard said the black male was wearing a baseball hat and that she could not see his hair.

2. Couillard described the other male as white, approximately 50-60 years old, 5'11, slender build, and also wearing a baseball hat. Couillard described the white male as "rough looking" and believed he may have been homeless.

3. Couillard described the third suspect as a white female, approximately 40 years old, 5'6, 150lbs, with should length blond hair, which was in a pony tail.

4. Couillard described the fourth suspect as a black female, approximately 50 years old, 5'5 150lbs.

Couillard could not recall where each individual was standing during the incident, however, she said suspects 2-4 were standing close to the black male. Further, Couillard said both males were wearing dark hooded sweatshirts. Couillard could not provide any other additional information pertaining to the suspects, including possible clothing or names associated to them. I asked Couillard how confident she would be to select the suspect from a photo lineup and she said she did believe she could identify each of them. I asked Couillard to explain specifically why she believed the four individuals were involved. Couillard said she only observed one other person the on the gaming machine during the incident time, whom she said is a regular at the bar. Further, Couillard said it was very unusual for all of the parties to be surrounding the machine. Couillard could not identify who specifically would have damaged the locking mechanism. Couillard said she did not notice the machine was damaged until she was closing the bar at approximately 0100hrs. Couillard said she last observed the machine in normal condition while closing the bar on 11/19/13 at approximately 0200hrs.

CASE DISPOSITION

At this time no other information is available pertaining to the suspects in this case. Caze advised she would contact me with more specific information in regards to the property loss after she speaks with the leasing company, Reds Novelty Ltd. Additional information will be supplemented to this report as it is received.
