

**CITY OF WEST ALLIS
RESOLUTION R-2026-2957**

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT WITH LIME TO ALLOW SHORT-TERM COMMERCIAL RENTAL OF ELECTRIC SCOOTERS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC

WHEREAS, Neutron Holdings, Inc. d/b/a Lime (“Lime Scooters”) has expressed interest in entering into an agreement with the City of West Allis to provide short-term commercial rental of electric scooters to the general public within the City under the restrictions in law and a short-term agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council approved a pilot agreement with Lime Scooters on July 30, 2024 (Resolution R-2024-0395); this agreement expired on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council approved a subsequent short-term agreement with Lime Scooters on March 18, 2025 (Resolution R-2025-0371); this agreement expired on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared another agreement with Lime Scooters to allow short-term commercial rental of electric scooters to the general public; this agreement is set to expire on December 31, 2026;

WHEREAS, in 2025, Lime Scooters began operations April 24 and ended operations on November 25; a total of 10,065 people used Lime scooters in 2025, logging 53,143 miles on 33,109 trips; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to allow Lime Scooters to operate in 2026 to provide an alternate form of transportation to the general public; and

WHEREAS, City staff will continue to review usage, safety, and other data to determine the long-term viability of commercial electric scooters;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of West Allis that the agreement attached to this resolution is approved and the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City.

SECTION 1: **ADOPTION** “R-2026-2957” of the City Of West Allis Municipal Resolutions is hereby *added* as follows:




