E. CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

Brianna Olson, 2210 S. 75 Street, stated numerous concerns and nuisances associated with Pawn America and she is requesting the non-renewal of Pawn America's licenses.

Jaclyn Kirch, 2316 S. 76 Street, expressed her concerns regarding Pawn America and how the goals of cleaning up the City and filling vacant properties won't be achieved if Pawn America is in the City of West Allis. Jaclyn is requesting the non-renewal of Pawn America's licenses.

Pauline Gelainyk, 2203 S. 74 Street, commented on safety and crime concerns regarding Pawn America.

Carol J. Szymanski, 2225 S. 75 Street, remarked on the transition of the neighborhood since Pawn America opened and how safety and crime are issues.

Stephanie Baudo, 2230 S. 76 Street, commented on the atmosphere and clientele Pawn America attracts to the neighborhood. She addressed concerns regarding the alley, parking, safety and crime.

Daryl Olson, 1943 S. 74 Street, stated Pawn America is not the type of business that is good for the neighborhood, and that it should be relocated.

Carla Krueger, 2245 S. 75 Street, expressed her concerns regarding the safety in the neighborhood and traffic concerns relative to Pawn America.

Nathan Bird, 2257 S. 75 Street, stated with the onset of Pawn America he feels unsafe by both patrons and the traffic associated with Pawn America. He feels Pawn America is too large for that area, and should relocate.
