Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on September 15, 2009, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That Doyle Food Services, Inc., by registered agent, Thomas Doyle, was served a copy of the summons and complaint;
- 2. That Thomas Doyle failed to appear to contest the complaint and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
- 3. That the conduct of Thomas Doyle and Doyle Food Services, Inc. described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04 (a)(1);
- 4. That in particular, Thomas Doyle's failure to appear at two License and Health Committee meetings as ordered, is contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04 (a)(1).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to not renew the Class B tavern license of Doyle Food Services, Inc.

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class B Tavern License of Doyle Food Services, Inc be not renewed.
