Dear Ms. Becker:

On August 16, 2010, you applied for a permit for a 13 foot 6 inch wide by 20 foot 6 inch deep shelter roof erected on the above referenced property. This shelter roof is located 4 feet from the next mobile home.

Your permit is denied because the shelter roof is in violation of Section 9.21(4)(c)3 of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code. The shelter roof cannot exceed 10 feet in depth nor be closer than 6 feet to the adjacent mobile home. Your shelter roof is 10 feet 6 inches too deep and 2 feet too close to the adjacent mobile home.

You may appeal this decision to the City of West Allis Common Council. Should you wish to appeal, address a letter to the Honorable Mayor and Common Council stating specifically what you wish to appeal. This letter should be mailed to the City Clerk's Office so that your request can be placed on the agenda of the next Common Council meeting.
