CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CLAIM

After exiting the bus at the bus stop located on the southwest corner of 64th Street and Lincoln Avenue, Ms. Lozano tripped on a severed post sticking out of the sidewalk approximately two inches. See attached photographs.

Signs of municipal work were evident including newly poured concrete slabs near the severed post. Also, near the location were markings consisting of city construction paint markings showing that City workers have performed work nearby the location of the hazard. Therefore, City workers charged with marking the street for purposes of construction were present near the severed post yet failed to do anything about it.

The City has a duty to maintain the sidewalks in the City but they have failed to remove tripping hazards for which they are responsible. Also, there were no warnings or guard related to the tripping hazard.

ITEMIZATION OF RELIEF SOUGHT

Ms. Lozano sustained injuries including a fractured pelvis, bruising to her knee and right arm as well as numbness from her elbow to her fingers. The actual value of the claim vastly exceeds the statutory cap under §893.80, Wis. Stats., of \$50,000.00. The estimated itemization of damages are as follows:

Medical Expenses:

\$35,000.00

Loss of Earnings:

\$25,000.00

Pain, Suffering & Disability:

\$80,000.00

These estimates shall be updated after Ms. Lozano complete treatment. However, given the statutory cap, the Claimant seeks the \$50,000.00 limits.
