## Dear Commissioners:

We know you are aware of the financial situation that the City is going to face due to the loss of shared revenue and/or levy limits in our upcoming 2004 City budget. We regret that we may have to seriously consider cutting services or eliminating positions. However, with 83% of our budget in salaries and benefits, our main option for true savings is in those areas.

Some City departments have already responded with reorganizations in the effort to save money. These departments include Health, Development, Engineering, and the Clerk/Treasurer's Office. We also have a current proposal from the Public Works Department Head to go to curbside-alleyside pick up, which would eliminate six to seven positions savings approximately \$350,000 per year. However, a tremendous morale problem exists with a number of our City workers complaining that they do not see the same kind of effort, savings, or cuts from the Police and Fire Departments.

Recently, it was pointed out to us by Chief Puschnig that the Police Department has taken steps to raise new revenues, change procedures where necessary, and is currently holding many positions open. Through these various means, Chief Puschnig has saved \$300,000-\$400,000 last year and continues to save similar amounts this year due to keeping these vacant positions open.

In regards to the Fire Department, we have not seen the same effort. A recent reorganization provided by the Fire Department actually added another Assistant Chief position from savings that could have been realized when the Public Works Department took over maintenance of vehicles from the mechanic position being eliminated. Very little money, if any, was saved on it and will most likely cost the City more money in the future. It seems that Chief Hook does not understand the need for innovative thinking, financial alternatives, or different ways to deliver the same services. He does not seem to understand that cuts will be necessary from his department, and we must do things in different ways to save money.

We hope you will continue to seek changes from the Police Department, but more importantly, we ask for your cooperation in bringing this needed direction to the Fire Department. We will cooperate and support any decisions you make regarding these matters.
