The following is a synopsis of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service for the month of March 2010.

Police report incidents involving licensed businesses:

**Incident reports:**

**Case 10-001948, 03/03/10 at 0155hrs. Ubie's Double Vision, 5501 W Burnham St**

On the above date and time officers responded to Ubie's Double Vision for a report of a disorderly party refusing to leave and then breaking the glass in the front door. The bartender on duty is the complainant. A male party who fled the scene before officers arrived was eventually arrested for Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property.

**Call 10-002049, 03/06/10 at 0108hrs. Smokin Joe's, 6139 W Beloit Rd**

On the above date and time officers responded to a call from the bartender of a disorderly patron in the tavern threatening employees and refusing to leave. The male was still on scene when officers arrived and was arrested for Disorderly Conduct.

**Case 10-002308, 03/15/10 at 0243hrs. Las Palmas, 1901 S 60 St**

On the above date and time an officer on routine patrol observed several parties inside the tavern with the lights off. Investigation revealed 12 parties in the tavern consuming alcohol after hours. Two of the owners who were present admitted to having a meeting and that several employee's friends were there and had been served after hours. The two owners were cited as well as an employee who was arrested for Obstructing.

**Case 10-002596, 03/23/10 at 0004hrs. Night Court, 7127 W National Ave**

On the above date and time officers responded to a call from the bartender at Night Court who reported he was assaulted. The bartender stated that he had sent four parties on their respective ways after a fight inside the tavern over a pool game. Two of the parties came back into the bar and accosted him. They fled before officers arrived.
