
The big issue facing the WACCC, even larger in scope than the Auction, was the notice they received at the end of the 4th Quarter from the School District terminating their lease of the space in the Franklin Fieldhouse as of June 30, 2003. The School District needs the space for 4K classes.

The Auction went well grossing \$13,500 and netting the WACCC \$7,600. The money will be used for equipment purchases. In other areas of activity two new groups were trained during the 4th Quarter (Y.O.U.R. and the West Allis Womens Club). On the individual level six people joined the WACCC. Members of the WACCC produced 20 shows bringing the total for the year to 211. In the area of training three computer editing classes were held and one each for producers, portable equipment and studio equipment usage.

The WACCC has also launched their own Website at wacmc.org. I've been to the site and it's very easy to navigate, quite inclusive and a good promotional/informational tool for the WACCC.

The WACCC has again fulfilled the requirements stated in their 2002 goals and objectives. I recommend providing 4th quarter funding for the WACCC.
