**THE WEST ALLIS COMMON COUNCIL TO KATHERINE WISNIEWSKI:**

You are hereby notified that a sworn complaint, a copy of which is attached, has been duly made and filed, requesting a hearing on suspension or revocation of the 2022-2024 Operator's License, issued under license number BART-513. The accompanying sworn complaint identifies the allegations against you and requests a hearing for suspension or revocation of the above referenced license pursuant to the provision of Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2) and West Allis Code §§ 9.49 and 9.60.

**NOW THEREFORE**, you, Katherine Wisniewski, are hereby summoned to appear before the Public Safety Committee of the West Allis Common Council on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter can be heard at the West Allis City Hall located at 7525 W. Greenfield Avenue in the City of West Allis, to admit or deny the allegations in the complaint. You may be represented by counsel on this date.

In the case of your failure to appear as required by this summons, the allegations in the complaint against you shall be taken as true and, if the Public Safety Committee of the West Allis Common Council finds the allegations sufficient, a recommendation

that your license(s) be suspended or revoked will be made to the full Common Council. The Common Council may then vote to suspend or revoke your license(s).

You are further notified that if you appear as required by this summons and contest the allegations in the complaint, a hearing will be scheduled at a later date before the Public Safety Committee, at which time you may be represented by counsel, cross examine the witnesses who testify adversely against you, and present witnesses in your own behalf. A written transcript of said hearing shall be made and you may obtain a copy of the transcript of this proceeding at your expense.

Aldersperson Daniel Roadt of the West Allis Common Council, being duly sworn on oath, deposes and states as a complaint under Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ag) against Katherine Wisniewski for her current 2022-2024 Operator's License as follows:


1. That the complainant is a resident of the City of West Allis.
2. That this complaint is based upon personal knowledge and records maintained by the City of West Allis that the complainant has used in the past and found to be reliable.
3. That Katherine Wisniewski currently holds an Operator's License issued pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.17, issued under license number BART-513 valid through July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2024.
4. That Katherine Wisniewski appeared in front of the West Allis Public Safety Committee on April 18, 2023, where she was approved for the Operator's License BART-513.

5. That at said appearance on April 18, 2023, in front of the Public Safety Committee, Katherine Wisniewski had either a suspended or revoked driver's license. When asked about how she arrived at the meeting, Katherine Wisniewski stated that she had been given a ride to the meeting from her boyfriend and she did not drive to the meeting and her boyfriend would be picking her up as well. This statement was recorded and is publicly available on the City of West Allis YouTube page under "4-18-2023 Public Safety and Public Works Committee Meetings."
6. That the West Allis Information Technology department reviewed surveillance videos from the April 18, 2023, Common Council Meeting and provided said videos to the complainant regarding Katherine Wisniewski. Surveillance video from the exterior of West Allis City Hall shows Katherine Wisniewski driving and parking a dark colored sedan type vehicle to the meeting. It is further believed that Katherine Wisniewski also drove herself away from the meeting in that same vehicle.
7. That pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ag), the Operator's license issued to Katherine Wisniewski is subject to suspension or revocation for providing false statements to the common council or committee thereof in violation of West Allis Municipal Code §9.49(6), a municipal regulation adopted pursuant to Wis. Stat. §125.10, and violating Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ag)1.
