Subject: Repair Of Fueling Islands

Paul:

As discussed a couple of weeks ago, the fuel islands at the Municipal Yard require rather extensive repairs. What started as an apparent electrical problem led to ever increasing underground problems including the necessity of replacing various valves and equipment at the pump islands themselves. We determined that since we had to open up the concrete and expose the electrical it would be the prudent approach to replace this other equipment which was in various stages of failing at this time rather than going through this whole process again in the near future.

To that end, we have replaced all of the electrical conduits and wiring from the building to the pumps. As noted above, we are also having the sumps beneath the dispensers, valves, connectors and pipe removed and replaced. Finally, while not required, we also will replace the two diesel fuel dispensers with new high flow models which will allow for considerably more efficient fueling of vehicles.

While the Department has done all of the associated electrical and concrete work, we have contracted with Interstate Pump & Tank Inc. to perform a considerable portion of the tank work itself. The cost of that work is approximately \$11,000. In addition, the cost of purchasing and installing the new dispensers is approximately \$14,000. Finally, there will be approximately \$5,000 of concrete replaced in this project.

In order to pay for this contracted work and the concrete required for repairing the pavement and islands, I am herein requesting the transfer of funds from the Department's existing 2007 budget as follows:
