Dear Mayor and President and Members of the City of West Allis Common Council:

In July 2008, we provided you with a certified copy of SEWRPC Planning Report No. 50 (PR No. 50), A Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update for the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds, published in two parts in December 2007. We are now providing you a compact disk containing SEWRPC Technical Report, No. 39, Water Quality Conditions and Sources of Pollution in the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds, the companion report to PR No. 50.

Technical Report No. 39 (TR No. 39) sets forth comprehensive 1) inventories and analyses of measured water quality data, 2) instream and riparian habitat evaluations, and 3) inventory and simulation model information on point and nonpoint sources of pollution. The information presented in TR No. 39 was used in developing the regional water quality management plan update set forth in PR No. 50, and is a valuable resource for citizens, State and Federal agencies, counties and municipalities, nongovernmental organizations, private business, and academic institutions interested in water quality conditions in the greater Milwaukee watersheds.

The City is one of many designated management agencies with roles in plan implementation. It is respectfully requested that, upon the recommendation of appropriate committees, the Common Council endorse the water quality management plan update documented in SEWRPC PR No. 50 as a basis for decision-making in water quality matters dealing with 1) abatement of both point and nonpoint sources of water pollution; 2) improvement of instream, inlake, and riparian habitat; and 3) management of groundwater, and provide the Commission with the resolution of endorsement. A model resolution for plan endorsement that can be adapted for your use is included as Appendix T in Part Two of PR No. 50. Endorsement of the plan is important to help assure a common understanding among the various levels and agencies of government concerned with the many different aspects of regional water quality management and the physical development of the Region and to enable work to continue on plan implementation.

The Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust (SWWT) is a voluntary organization that has been formed to promote watershed-based implementation of the plan, to involve all and stakeholders in plan implementation, and to assist designated management agencies with plan implementation. The City is encouraged to actively participate in SWWT. More information on SWWT can be found at www.swwtwater.org.

Both TR No. 39 and PR No. 50 are published on the Commission web site (*www.sewrpc.org*, under "Data and Publications"). Limited additional printed or compact disk copies are available upon request. ### MODEL RESOLUTION FOR ENDORSEMENT OF THE REGIONAL WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE FOR THE GREATER MILWAUKEE WATERSHEDS

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, which was duly created by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin in accordance with Section 66.0309(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes* on the 8th day of August 1960, upon petition of the Counties of Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha, has the function and duty of making and adopting a master plan for the physical development of the Region; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Wisconsin has designated the seven-county Southeastern Wisconsin Region as an areawide water quality management planning area and the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission as the official water quality management planning agency for that area, all in accordance with the procedural requirements set forth in Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act; and

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, pursuant to its function and duty as
regional planning agency and its designation as a water quality management planning agency, has prepared an
adopted at its meeting held on the day of 200_, an update to the areawide water qualit
management plan set forth in a report entitled, SEWRPC Planning Report No. 50, A Regional Water Quality
Management Plan Update for the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds, published in 200_; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has transmitted certified copies of its resolution adopting the regional water quality management plan update for the greater Milwaukee watersheds, together with the aforementioned SEWRPC Planning Report No. 50, to the local units of government concerned and to the appropriate State and Federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, the (name of local governing body) has supported, participated in the financing of, and generally concurred in the regional planning programs undertaken by the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, and believes that the regional water quality management plan update prepared by the Commission is a sound and valuable guide to water quality management in the development of not only the Region but also the local community, and that the adoption of such plan by the (name of local governing body) will assure a common understanding by the units and agencies of government concerned and enable these units and agencies of government to program the necessary plan implementation work.
