



NARRATIVE

INITIAL CALL

On 09/10/14 at 2034hrs officers responded to Fiddler's, 6110 W. Burnham St., for a male party causing problems in the bar and refusing to leave. Upon arrival, I made contact with the bartender, Ricky R. Amborn, M/W 03/18/50, regarding the incident.

STATEMENT OF AMBORN

Amborn explained a male party, later identified as Tyreese D. Williams, M/B 12/10/79, entered the tavern and was walking around mumbling to himself. Amborn stated the male party was talking "gibberish" to other customers inside the tavern. Williams was telling several of the customers not to smoke or they are going to die.

Amborn stated he put up with Williams comments for about 30 minutes and eventually asked him to leave. Williams refused to leave the tavern and sat down on one of the bar stools. After Amborn asked Williams to leave and he refused, Williams stopped talking and was silent until officers arrived on scene.

CONTACT WITH WILLIAMS

Officer Christianson was already on scene when I arrived and was attempting to speak with Williams inside the tavern regarding the incident. When asked by Officer Christianson, Williams refused to provide his name. Officer Christianson advised Williams did say something to her, but she could not hear him because her police radio was too loud. When asked again for his name, Williams refused to provide it.

I advised Williams to step outside of the tavern so officers could speak with him without disrupting the other customers. Once outside, both Officer Christianson

and I repeatedly asked Williams for his name. Williams refused to provide his name and told Officer Christianson he already gave it to her, which he did not. I asked Williams for his last name, and he told me he did not have one because he was Hebrew.

Williams refused to provide officers with information about the incident and just laughed at officers when we asked him questions.

ARREST OF OFFENDER

Based on Williams behavior inside the tavern, and the fact he refused to provide officers his name, Williams was placed under arrest for disorderly conduct and obstructing. I transported Williams to the station for processing. On the way into the station, Williams threatened to beat me up and repeatedly laughed at me.

BOOKING ROOM

Once at the station, Williams refused to cooperate with officers while he was being searched and had to be held by several officers while I used the Fast ID machine in an attempt to identify him. Williams was placed in a cell while I completed the pre-booking process for him.

After I finished pre-booking Williams, I asked him to exit the cell so I could obtain his photograph and fingerprints. Williams ignored my request and refused to exit the cell. I repeatedly asked Williams to exit the cell, and he refused and would not say anything. Eventually Williams replied, "I know you want me," but still refused to exit the cell.

Williams was left in the cell and was later released from the station, with his municipal citations, during third shift.

CUSTODIAL INTERVIEW

Based on the fact Williams was uncooperative at the tavern and in the booking room at the station, I did not attempt to obtain an in custody statement from him regarding the incident.

CASE DISPOSITION

On 09/10/14 officers responded to Fiddler's for a male party, Williams, refusing to leave the bar. Williams was harassing the customers and when asked to leave several times, he refused. Williams refused to provide officers with his name and stated he did not have a last name. Williams was taken into custody for disorderly conduct and obstructing an officer and transported to the station for processing under #14-004282. Williams was issued two municipal citations for DC and

NARRATIVE

Officer Tuschl reports...

INITIAL RESPONSE

On 09/11/14 at about 0910hrs I responded to the intersection of S. 75th St and W. Greenfield Ave for a report of a M/B walking bare foot and into traffic (W.A.P.D Call# 14-40645). W.A.P.D had received two separate calls about this individual (later identified as Tyreese D. Williams) walking into traffic and walking bare foot. Once I arrived in the area I located Tyreese near the intersection of S. 72nd St and W. Greenfield Ave. I exited my marked Police squad and soke with him.

ON-SCENE INTERACTION WITH TYREESE D. WILLIAMS

When I first observed Tyreese I confirmed he was walking barefoot and was only wearing a white t-shirt (it was approximately 50 Degrees F outside) and he appeared to be cold. I explained to Tyreese the reason why I was stopping him and he denied walking into traffic. Tyreese stated he was currently walking home and I offered to give him a ride there. Tyreese initially denied my request to give him a ride home and stated he would walk. I explained to Tyreese how the Police Department had already received three separate calls from citizens who were concerned about his welfare. Tyreese stated he was fine and would continue walking home.

I continued to offer Tyreese I ride home and he started to bring up how his property was not turned over to him when he was released from the West Allis Police Department. I explained to Tyreese I had no knowledge about this because I did not release him. After talking with Tyreese for a bit, I was able to convince him to accept a ride home from me. I placed Tyreese in the back of my Police squad and started transporting him back to his residence. As we reached his residence Tyreese indicated he would be unable to enter his apartment because his keys were not with him. Tyreese indicated his keys were with the rest of his property at the Police station.

I reviewed Officer Schweitzer's supplement report and observed Tyreese had refused to accept his property when released. I asked Tyreese if he would be willing to accept his property if I give him a ride to the Police station and get it for him. Tyreese stated he would be willing to do that, however he would not sign for any of his property.

I subsequently gave Tyreese a cou	rtesy ride	back to	o the Polic	e station	and had
