CASE SYNOPSIS

Pto. Zingale reports...

Arrested outside of Metropolis, 6330 W. Greenfield Ave. for Disorderly Conduct was Dalisia NMI Ortega. Ortega got into a verbal argument with other kids in the area. She got loud and profane and began to fight with security officer, David B. Rogers when he tried to stop the disturbance. She was issued a local citation for Disorderly Conduct and released to her mother, Kelly Martin who was advised of this incident. The other juveniles left the area and were not located.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

On 01-31-03 at 2305 hrs. I advised dispatch that I would be in the area of Metropolis, 6330 W. Greenfield Ave. monitoring a very large crowd of approximately 300 juveniles who were leaving the nightclub. These juveniles were very loud and disruptive as they were obstructing both pedestrian and vehicular traffic in the area. While I was outside speaking to a group a juveniles, a loud disturbance erupted behind me. I turned around and observed Metropolis security, David B. Rogers attempting to separate a female person identified later as Dalisia Ortega from the crowd. I could hear Ortega using profane language toward another group of juveniles as she shouted at them and challenged them to a fight. Ortega was very out of control as she swung and kicked her arms and legs at Rogers repeatedly so she could get away from him.

Pto. Stachula and I assisted Rogers with controlling Ortega by placing her into handcuffs, which were double locked and detained her for investigation purposes.

STATEMENT/DAVID ROGERS

Rogers told me that he is employed by Metropolis as a security officer. He said that he was outside monitoring the crowd when he saw Ortega get into a verbal confrontation with another group of juveniles. He said that Ortega was highly agitated and appeared to be trying to start a fight, so he pulled her away from the crowd in attempt to diffuse the situation. Rogers said that as he was separating Ortega from the crowd, she was trying to elbow and kick him repeatedly and that he wanted her arrested for creating a disturbance. Rogers said that he did not get hurt while separating Ortega from the other juveniles nor did he see any parties physically fighting with each other.

INVESTIGATION CONT.

I attempted to, but was not able to locate the other juveniles involved in the altercation. Due to the fact that Ortega had created a disturbance, Rogers wishing to pursue charges against Ortega, I told Ortega that she was under arrest for disorderly conduct. Pto. Stachula conveyed Ortega to the West Allis Police Station for the booking process.

STATEMENT/DALISIA ORTEGA

While at the police station, I told Ortega that I was interested in hearing about what had happened outside the nightclub. She told me that she got upset when a group of other juveniles began to make threats to beat up one of her friends. She admitted to getting upset with the other juveniles. She told these other youths that it was real big of them (referring to the other group of juveniles) to pick on her friend and that if they had a problem with her friend, then they might as well have a problem with her too. Ortega said that she was only trying to defend her friend and that she did not know any of the other juveniles involved.

Ortega said that she was struck in the face by one of the juveniles and that she hit this juvenile back. Ortega said that is when the security tried to separate her from the group and that she put up some resistance with security.
