
Dear Mrs. Adams,

My name is Ayame Metzger and I represent Steve and Cheryl Colgrove in the matter regarding "Piggy." Mrs. Colgrove has received your letter dated June 11, 2015. However, Section 7.12, as cited in your letter, has been rescinded and replaced as of March 2015. Without being properly cited with an ordinance violation, the 30-day notice of removal cannot be enforced.

Cheryl and Steve do not deny that they have a pet pig on their property. They were unaware that they were in violation of any West Allis codes. They disagree that Piggy violates the statute, but understand your position. Because they would like to be as cooperative and compliant as possible, they are respectfully requesting additional time to make arrangements for their pet. They are in the process of petitioning the Common Counsel, and failing a change in the code, would need time to sell their home in New Mexico in order to have the finances available to move outside of the city. They respectfully ask that they be provided with this additional time. They believe they would need a year to sell their home and move into another outside of the city. Seeing as Piggy is up to date on vaccines, is micro-chipped, and has not caused any complaints from neighbors, we believe this is a reasonable request.
