The following is a synopsis of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service for the months of February and March.

Incident reports:

Case # 12-001485, 02/19/2012, at approx. 1313 hrs – Larry Michaels Tavern, 8900 W. Greenfield Ave.

On 02/19/2012, at approx. 1313 hrs, Officers Barwick and Ketterhagen conducted a tavern check at Larry Michaels Tavern (8900 W. Greenfield Ave). The bartender on duty did not have a valid bartender's license. It was confirmed through the City of West Allis that her bartender's license expired in 2008. The bartender and owner of the business were both cited.

Case # 12-001376, 02/19/2012, at 0150 hrs – Danny's Lounge, (1900 S. 60th St).

On 02/19/2012, at 0150 hrs, Officers responded to Danny's Lounge (1900 S. 60th St) regarding a report of gunshots fired. Upon Officers arrival they spoke with witnesses who reported there was a verbal argument between 7-9 individuals directly outside the bar; during this argument one individual pulled out a handgun and fired two shots in the air. Two .45 caliber shell casings were recovered by officers at the scene. Officers developed suspects in this case and also arrested a person for DWI as a result of this investigation. Investigation is still ongoing.

Call # 12-007459, 02/24/2012, at 0116 hrs – The Stumble Inn Tavern (6404 W. National Ave).

On 02/24/2012, at 0116 hrs, Officers were dispatched to the Stumble Inn Tavern (6410 W. National Ave) regarding a trouble call. Investigation revealed there was a physical confrontation between two male individuals; one of the male party's involved in the confrontation believed the other male participant was flirting with his girlfriend. This unknown person left the scene before Officers arrived – no further police action was taken at the request of the complainant.

Case # 12-001563, 02/26/2012, at 0148 hrs – Las Palmas (1901 S. 60 St).

On 02/26/2012, at 0148 hrs, Officers were flagged down regarding a fight at Las Palmas (1901 S. 60th St). Investigation revealed that an intoxicated male individual allegedly made a derogatory comment toward a female patron in the restaurant; this resulted in the female's husband throwing a margarita glass at the person who made the comment. The margarita glass missed the individual, but broke a window. The two male subjects proceeded to fight in the front vestibule area of the restaurant; both parties were arrested and cited for Disorderly Conduct.

Case # 12-001643, 02/29/2012, at 0117 hrs – Danny's Lounge, (1900 S. 60th St).

On 02/29/2012, at 0117 hrs, Officers responded to Danny's Lounge (1900 S. 60 St) after Officer Noche stopped a vehicle and the driver told him about a disturbance in the bar. Investigation revealed the driver who Officer Noche pulled over was responsible for punching a patron in the bar who he thought was heckling the bartender; in addition, he proceeded to pour his drink on this person at which time he was told to leave by bar security.

This person was taken into custody for D/C, Probation Violation, and transported to CJF. Two other persons in the bar were arrested: One for an active warrant and a second is going to be cited for failure to cooperate with the police.

Case # 12-001670, 03/01/2012, at 0200 hrs – The Spot Lite Gentleman's Club (6426 W. Greenfield Ave).

On 03/01/2012, at approx. 0201 hrs, Officers responded to The Spot Lite Gentleman's Club (6426 W. Greenfield Ave) for a report of 5 people fighting in the road. Upon Officers arrival there were people milling in the road and on the sidewalk, but no one was fighting. Based on witness statements one male individual was arrested for Disorderly Conduct. He was transported to the station for processing – he was cited and released.

Case # 12-001794, 03/05/2012, 0116 hrs – Flapper's Tavern (7527 W. Becher St).

On 03/05/2012, at approximately 0116 hrs, Officers responded to Flapper's Tavern (7527 W. Becher St) regarding an anonymous report of underage drinking. Investigation revealed that the bartender served alcohol to two underage patrons. Officers investigation confirmed this information and citations were issued to the bartender and the two underage persons.

Tobacco and Alcohol Compliance checks:
