Equipment failures and loss of personnel have hurt the educational channel's operations during the 3rd quarter. Their production assistant left for a full-time position and equipment problems again surfaced during the taping of Hale and Central football games. They were able to get the games on channel 13, which were well received by their audience.

The District will again have video clubs in all of their schools and the Community Relations Office has increased the production requirements for the clubs. The Public Information Officer stated that the teachers and students are very enthusiastic, and he expects them to meet the increased requirements. They intend to cover concerts, theatrical performances and other events.

The School District is keeping on track with their goals and objectives for 2006, and I recommend $3^{\rm rd}$ quarter funding for the School District's Educational Access Channel.
