Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health Committee meeting held on January 6, 2015, the Committee finds:

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC, by agent Mary Jo Burback, was served a copy of the summons and complaint;
- 2. That Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC, by agent Mary Jo Burback, admitted to the allegations that were stated in the complaint, other than paragraph 8, and, thus, the allegations in the complaint, other than paragraph 8, are considered to be true;
- 3. That the conduct of Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC, by agent Mary Jo Burback, described in the complaint substantially relates to the food-related permit activity contrary to Sections 7.04(16)(a)2, 7.04(16)(a)3, and 7.04(16)(a)5 of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code;
- 4. That in particular, Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC's failure to properly dispose of its refuse and recycling, service of food beyond the scope of its food-related permit, and allowance of smoking and ashtrays in its premises is contrary to Sections 7.04(16)(a)2, (a)3, and (a)5 of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code;

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

 That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to suspend the Food-Related Permit of Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC from January 25, 2015 at 6:00 a.m. until January 31, 2015 at 11:59 p.m.

## RECOMMENDATION:

1. Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Food-Related Permit of Morgan Murphy Enterprises, LLC be suspended from January 25, 2015 at 6:00 a.m. until January 31, 2015 at 11:59 p.m.
