Maddron jumped on a person, who he thought was involved in the first confrontation and began physically fighting.

Brian said his security officer (William M Bauler), grabbed Maddron from behind to stop him (Maddron), from fighting with other patrons. He said Maddron took a swing at Bauler (security), and grazed his right cheek. Maddron was physically escorted outside, while Brian called the police. Brian said they pushed Maddron out the front door and then locked the door, so Maddron could not get back inside.

Brian stated while they were waiting for the police, Maddron was pounding on the front glass windows so hard, he thought they were going to break.

### **SECURITY-WILLIAM BAULER**

I spoke with the security officer (William Bauler), who stated that Maddron was involved in a disturbance with another party and was escorted out of the bar. Bauler told me that Maddron left the bar with his wife and returned about 30 minutes later and went into the bar and confronted a person and began fighting.

Bauler told me that he grabbed Maddron from behind to break up the fight and Maddron took a swing at him and glanced the left side of his face. Bauler escorted him out the front door and then secured it and did not let Maddron back inside. Bauler told me that while he was waiting for the police, Maddron was pounding on the glass windows outside.

### **CONTACT WITH MADDRON**

I spoke with Maddron on scene, who was not that cooperative with telling me what happened. I asked him if he was escorted out of the bar about thirty minutes prior to this and he said yes. I asked him if he left the bar and took his wife home and he said yes. I asked him if he was involved in a verbal argument with another patron and he said yes.

I asked Maddron when he left with his wife, why he did not stay at home. Maddron told me that he needed to confront the person who started something with his wife. I asked Maddron if he thought that by coming back would cause problems and he said, "Have to do, what you have to do." I asked him if he was in a fight when he came back and he said yes.

It should be noted that Maddron had some minor scrapes and redness to his legs and arms. I informed Maddron that he was being arrested for disorderly conduct and I handcuffed him and placed him in the back of my squad car.

### **LACK OF CONSENT**

Brian told me that he did not give anyone permission to fight or cause a disturbance inside the bar. Bauler (security), also said he did not give anyone permission to hit him.

### **BOOKING**

While I was booking Maddron, he kept asking me why he was arrested. I told him that he caused a disturbance the first time and was escorted out of the bar. I then told him he left with his wife and then returned a short time later to confront someone inside the bar. Maddron told me, "Yeah, wouldn't you do the same thing."

I informed him if he had a problem at the bar, he should have called the police like the owner did. Maddron's response was, "Yeah, right".

### **CASE DISPOSITION**

I issued Carl Maddron a local citation (M80143), for DC and he signed the PR bond. I gave him a court date of 10-14-03 at 0830 hrs. Carl was released from WAPD.

At approximately 0145 hrs., I received a call from Brian Malec (owner), telling me that Maddron returned to the bar and got into his face and told Brian to take a swing at him. Brian said he could not believe that Maddron returned and told him that he was calling the police again. After he told him that Maddron finally left.
