SUMMARY

On 11/2/19 at 0319hrs officers responded to Premier Sports Lounge, 1022 S 60 St for the security employee reporting that someone was trying to kill him. Officers arrived on scene and found only security officers, owners and bartenders inside the business. Security officer Steven C. Thompson, M/B 11/30/80, reported that he physically removed a customer from the business. At some point, Thompson heard numerous people yelling about the same male now had a firearm outside of the bar. Officers arrived on scene and did not locate anyone outside. Owners were unable to open any video from the business. Investigation is on-going.

DISPATCH TO CALL/ARRIVAL ON SCENE

On 11/2/19 at 0319hrs officers responded to Premier Sports Lounge, 1022 S 60 St for a report of the male security guard hiding in the basement after a male had just attempted to shoot him. Dispatch provided a description of the male but stated the suspect was outside of the business and that the security officer had ran into the basement.

I arrived on scene and observed a male party near the entrance of the business. I attempted to order the male party to walk towards officers but he ignored me. He did respond back to me but he refused to walk towards my direction. He eventually sat down on the ground at the front step of the business. The male, later identified as Deandre Harris, would not cooperate with any commands. He eventually laid down on his stomach and was taken into custody without incident.

As Harris was being detained, Tabitha Harris and Steven Thompson (security guard) walked to the doorway of the business. I went inside the business and spoke with Harris inside.

STATEMENT OF BUSINESS OWNER - TABITHA HARRIS

I met with Harris who identified herself as the owner. Harris stated she was working all night and did not observe any issues inside of the bar. Harris confirmed she is married to Deandre but he was too intoxicated to work at the time. Harris stated she did not hear anything occurring outside and did not think the business had any patrons causing issues.

In regard to the CCTV cameras, Harris confirmed they have numerous cameras but

none that would face the exterior of the business. Harris stated the only Deandre knows how to access the camera system. Harris stated she did not know if there was a computer, tablet or phone access to the cameras. Harris did not save anything to log into the system herself.

I requested Harris provide the police department with copies of the video from an hour before up until 10 minutes after the police were called.

ATTEMPT FOLLOW UP

On 11/5/19 at 2300hrs I checked the business and observed the business being closed.

On 11/6/19 at 2345hrs I checked the business and observed the business being closed.

On 11/7/19 at 0600hrs I called Harris at (414) 803-8452 and left her a voicemail to turn over a copy of the recorded video from the business as soon as possible.

On 11/7/19 at 2315hrs I made phone contact with Deandre Harris. Deandre advised that the business is planning to close and his installed cameras have not worked for the last several months. Harris stated his last planned open days of business will be the 8th and 9th of November.

CASE DISPOSITION

Due to the lack of video evidence provided by the business, lack of witness statements from employees inside of the business to confirm whether or not the incident started inside, the lack of additional witnesses outside the business, and the lack of the victim observing someone with a firearm, no additional follow up will be completed. If parties come forward at a later time to provide statements or information regarding suspects, follow up will be completed at that time.

NARRATIVE

At the time of this investigation I was wearing my WAPD issued body camera, which was functional and activated. See video recording for precise details as the following is a summary based off little or no review.

INITIAL DISPATCH

On 11/02/19 at approximately 0319 hrs. Officers were dispatched to Premier Sports Bar, 1022 S. 60 St. for a report of a male with a firearm outside of the bar.

CONTACT STEVEN THOMPSON-VICTIM

I arrived on scene and assisted with detaining a male, later identified as Deandrea D. Harris (m/b [REDACTED]), who was standing outside of the bar. After handing the male off to Officers Olson and Budish, I spoke with the victim,

identified as Steven C. Thompson (m/b [REDACTED]).

Thompson stated on 11/02/19 at approximately 0000 hrs., he was working as security at the bar when a m/b Thompson described as being approximately 40 years old wearing a blue jacket with fur around the collar and red hat entered the bar. Thompson stated the male pushed passed him as he entered the bar. Thompson stated he didn't want to start a confrontation in the bar so he went to talk to the owner's wife about the male, who in turn stated the male was the owner's, Deandre D. Harris (m/b [REDACTED] cousin. Thompson stated he let the incident pass and continued working security.

Thompson stated around bar close, he was waiting around the bar to get paid and the unknown male approached him and began to grab him on his jacket and shirt and began to punch him approximately 4-5 times in Thompson's face. Thompson stated the male left the bar. Thompson stated the male re-entered the bar and approached him a second time and attempted to assault Thompson a second time when Thompson grabbed the male and told him he didn't want to fight.

Thompson stated Harris pushed the male out of the bar, but the male came back to the door at which point all parties inside the bar started yelling that the male had a firearm. Thompson stated he ran into the basement and contacted police. Thompson stated he never observed the male with the firearm.

LACK OF CONSENT

Thompson did not consent to being struck in the face numerous times by the unknown male.

Officer Schmidt reports:

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 11/02/19 at approximately 0319 hrs, officers responded to a weapons call at Premier Sports Lounge, 1022 S. 60 St. Steven C. Thompson (m/b, [REDACTED]), who worked security at the front door, was reportedly assaulted by a patron and overheard the owners say that the party had a firearm. Officers arrived on scene, determined the problem party left, and spoke with the owners/bartenders, as they reportedly knew the suspect.

BARTENDER STATEMENTS

I spoke with Latoya T. Ragland (f/b, [REDACTED]) and Alexiah M. Love (f/b, [REDACTED]), who both stated they did not witness any altercation that took place. Ragland stated prior to officers arrival, she heard someone banging on the window of the tavern from the outside, but did not look outside. Neither Ragland or Love were able/willing to provide information concerning officers investigation.

Interview with DeAndre Harris (B/M11/02/75)

Upon arrival to Premier Sports bar, a black male wearing blue jeans and a white tank top, was standing outside the bar, later identified as DeAndre Harris (B/M [REDACTED]). DeAndre Harris was ordered to the ground and detained. Once we

were able to make contact with the bouncer, and all the other bartenders inside the bar we determined DeAndre to not be the party involved. DeAndre was taken out of handcuffs and taken into the bar.

DeAndre stated he was inside the bar drinking all night. DeAndre was very intoxicated to the point of not being able to stand on his feet, without holding on to the bar.

DeAndre stated there was a guy who just showed up and threw something at his window, breaking a panel of glass out of the exterior door. DeAndre stated he did not know who the subject was. DeAndre stated he opened the door and went to look who did it but the subject who did it was just yelling things at him and left in an unknown direction. DeAndre stated there was never a gun involved.

When asked for the video surveillance cameras, DeAndre kept saying the cameras don't face the area in question. DeAndre was asked multiple times to check the camera system because officers observed multiple cameras in the bar that could possibly have picked the incident up.

DeAndre was asked again to see the video footage, DeAndre stated the bouncer and the subject never got into an argument and there was never a gun involved, changing his story to now the subject was in the bar prior to the incident occurring. DeAndre repeated himself multiple times stating he does not know what was going on, refusing to cooperate with the Police.
