The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of October.

Incident reports:

Case # 12-009268, 10/21/2012, at approx. 0238 hrs –Network Tavern, 9541 W. Cleveland Ave.

On 10/21/2012, 0238 hrs, Officers responded to Network Tavern, 9541 W. Cleveland Ave. regarding a report of a fight outside the tavern (caller was a neighbor near the bar). Officers' investigation revealed that two individuals were arguing inside the bar over the size of a bottle of alcohol. The two parties eventually ended up going outside the bar where one of the individuals punched the other causing him to fall to the ground. The brother of the person who was knocked to the ground witnessed this incident and went outside the bar and punched the person who hit his brother. The individual the brother punched ended up with a broken nose. The two parties who threw punches were arrested; one for Battery; and the second for Substantial Battery.

Case # 12-009430, 10/26/2012, at approx. 0045 hrs – Walk Her Inn, 900 S. 74th St, 1641 S 68 St.

On 10/26/2012, at 0045 hrs, Officers responded to Walk Her Inn Tavern, 900 S. 74th St regarding a report of a male with a knife (Diane, owner of bar called the complaint into the PD). Upon Officers arrival they found an individual pinned to the ground by the victim who had a knife pulled on him. The person who was pinned on the ground reportedly pulled a knife out and placed the knife to the back of the neck of the person who had him pinned on the ground.

The offender reportedly was very intoxicated and retaliated after the bartender refused to serve him anymore alcohol because he was too intoxicated. Next, the offender took a beer from another patron in the bar (victim who had knife pulled on him). When the patron attempted to take back his beer from the offender, the offender pulled out the knife and held it to the back of the patron's neck. The offender was subsequently directed to the ground and pinned on the ground until Officers arrived. The offender was arrested by officers; he was transported to the station where he continued to be uncooperative with officers' during the booking process. The offender was charged with 2nd degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, CCW and Resisting Arrest. He was conveyed to CJF for ADA review.

Tobacco and Alcohol Compliance checks:
