For fifteen years of on time paid taxes , falsified sewage bills and non-existent storm sewage I definitely have the right to get my questions answered privately and not put myself into a seizure in front of a large group of people .

West Allis community is easily dominated by family households because parents are trying to get away from the Milwaukee public school system. Milwaukee Public schools have to advertise on tv. I am the one who is aware that if clocks were installed on your water metering devices that family household's sanitation expenses will sky rocket.

When I succeed in receiving a reduction in sanitation expense and your MMSD markup you will have to do the same for all single one income household owners in your discriminating community. So who will pay up the difference or the loss ?

FACT: for several years my water meter consumption did not exceed 6.0 ccf. There is no one in my house twelve to fourteen hours a day. But your minimum amount has increased every year.

FACT: According to your provided web site I obtained confirmation that majority of my neighbors and other areas have water meter consumption of 22 to 24 ccf. There does not have to be public hearing for you people to explain this illogic to me .

FACT: My struggle with epilepsy has relapsed , my needed sleep has been reduced, my driving license were suspended due to your behavior onto me, my blood pressure has multiplied, my interest and value in life. This is where attorneys and individuals like SCOTT POST come up with terminology like 'MENTAL DISSTRESS' that allows people to get away with multiple DUI's and violence in domestic or family household situations leading to lessened or dropped charges. Look at the drug houses you permit. This is what SCOTT POST studied in years of so called law school.

FACT : imagine what society, family households, GOV'T', economy, ATTORNEYS and justice system are going to be like in ten to fifteen years from now. My next life has to be better than this one ?

DO NOT SEND POLICE OFFICERS TO MY HOUSE ANYMORE, that is a joke to me. THAT IS WHEN I WILL RESIST AND THIS SEVEN YEAR, TWO SO CALLED MAYORS AND THREE POLICE CHIEFS ISSUE WILL BE PUBLICIZED. Like Milwaukee police department, Milwaukee Public schools, Ferguson and ST Louis, Missouri.

FACTS that you people would label irrelevance , extenuating circumstance, date expired, statue of limitations which SCOTT POST had to study for five to six years .

Your Engineering department can't even analyze a problem and write up a REPORT with their signature to support their decision, their title and responsibility. Peter Daniels and Micheal Lewis gave a stupid accusation to your cowardly provided Police Department . Officers Stacey Napioli ( ceased ) and Warwick barged into my house FEBRUARY 06, 2007 at 10:30 pm with guns to threaten me because PETER DANIELS insulted my education and experience in Engineering ? Your provided Police Department learned about my child family household years and know where my mistrust and low tolerance in peoples games came from. But they refuse to take a history check on me ; in front of me and take the responsibility for it.

I was accused of tampering with your provided water meter because my water consumption was extremely low. Your Public Works Department used another stupid terminology that the water meter had DRIED OUT. I was threatened again to have my supplied water shut off unless I stayed home from work so they could enter my house and inspect the meter for any tampering behavior. Three different Police Officers had to accompany them because again they learned and know about my young family household years.

FACT: In year 2007 I filed a suit against PETER DANIELS within the Milwaukee court system and away from your several year built friendships. But I was standing alone and I didn't have any neighbor support in the several year negligence in public service responsibility 'ALLEY'. PETER DANIELS told me he would complete this stupid 'WATER FLOW TEST' showing me that I had storm sewage and nothing to worry about.

But then he told me that WATER FLOW TEST was not necessary because the alley would be replaced in the spring of 2007. The negligence was never taken care of. A couple years later my north side neighbor submitted the same concern and PETER DANIELS carried out the same behavior out on her. Your irresponsible Engineering department wouldn't even fill a large recess in the ally with asphalt so at least some storm WATER FLOW could get by my tax paid property. My garage entrance has raised up to three inches in past winters due to freezing ground and freezing storm sewage under alley's negligent concrete. Teach your provided engineers how to write a 'REPORT'

FACT: In year 2008, I completed a ten week, three hours per Wednesday night citizen police achievement. Plaque was signed by Police Chief. Your blunt, cowardly and provided Police Department couldn't even figure out the truth why I completed an in depth citizen police course. I threw the obtained plaque in a closet and cracked the glass plate. My education, financial independence, versatility and more likely exceeds several of yours. I couldn't drive, couldn't work, couldn't live alone. You people, not the city tax payers, think you did nothing wrong?

FACT: 08/24/2009, 8400 West Beloit Rd, West Allis, WI I was severely injured on a bicycle with right clavicle broken in two places with arm universal having to be snapped back in place. I couldn't even get a REPORT from officer Christopher Sorhe (cs1841) with numerous witnesses and the individual who placed the '911' call for a woman driver who opened the driver door three feet in front of me. Danny Devine and this SCOTT POST told all the departments to ignore my needed and paid for services.

FACT: Currently or recently the fifteen year neglected alley has finally been replaced. At the notification of this project I received an estimate of \$1,165.60 due to the increased value of my single person, one income household. I only have one vehicle which is lucky to be used 3000 mi per year. But again you base charges for project on the physical square footage amount instead the amount of use that individuals and multiple vehicles in family households carry out in your service provided alley.

I was offered a lateral storm sewer addition into my property for a price of \$ 561.00. I discussed with Joseph M. Burtch and Michael G Lewis that this lateral could be rotated ninety degrees (clockwise), so I could have storm sewage service for my property like my neighbors receive. Michael G Lewis refused co-operation again and intentionally. I receive the entire storm run off from the alley's east entrance, the contribution from my property concrete entrance. Fifteen years of paid taxes; I still do not have any storm sewage service.

A second sewer crate was installed at the center 'T' part of the alley to satisfy the steep pitch on alley's west side and the 'T,s' entrance. I can show you several community alleys that have multiple storm sewers approx. ten feet about at alley's end instead of center with no more pitch than this ally. I want to hear Michael G Lewis engineering experience and reasoning to this.

Please show me this statute or Paving Plan ' AP-464 ' alley grade

Now this is three pages of facts and references and four hours of my weekend time for you people on this so called COUNCIL , except Danny Devine and certainly SCOTT POST to evaluate and handle this serious seven year situation without the tax payers' involvement


