**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT PROPOSED NATIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT  
WITH SIX REMNANT DEFENDANTS**

**WHEREAS**, a new proposed national opioids settlement has been reached with the following six regional distributors/dispenser defendants in pending opioid litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, those six defendants are Associated Pharmacies, Inc. (and American Associated Pharmacies); J M Smith Corporation; Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc.; Morris and Dickson Co.; North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc.; and United Natural Foods, Inc. (including its subsidiaries SuperValu and Advantage Logistics) - which are known in the litigation as the Six Remnant Defendants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible to receive direct payments from national opioids settlement matters pursuant to Wis. Stat. 165.12(7)(a);

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of West Allis, in the State of Wisconsin, that the City Attorney is hereby authorized to join, on behalf of the City, the national opioids settlement against the Six Remnant Defendants and execute any necessary documents.
