SUMMARY

Officer Carlson reports... **Criminal Damage to Property/DV...** On 12/13/13 at approximately 2314 hrs., Officers responded to the parking lot of the Draft located at 9105 W Lincoln Ave. for a report of a male individual who had broken a car window. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Jaymie R. Henrickson, F/W, 08/11/92, who stated her ex-boyfriend, Steven A. Raatz, M/W, 07/28/88, grabbed onto the driver side window and subsequently broke it. Henrickson and Raatz previously lived together. Raatz was arrested for Criminal Damage to Property/DV and was transported to the station where he was booked for the offense. Raatz was able to post bail and signed the Conditional waiver. Henrickson also signed a waiver of the no-contact order. This case will be reviewed by a Milwaukee County DA on 12/16/13 at 0830 hrs.

Officer Carlson reports...

INITIAL CALL

On 12/13/13 at approximately 2314 hrs., Officers responded to the parking lot of the Draft located at 9105 W Lincoln Ave. for a report of a male individual who had broken a car window.

CONTACT WITH JAYMIE R. HENRICKSON (VICTIM)

Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Jaymie R. Henrickson, F/W, 08/11/92, who stated she had been drinking with her friend, Jacqueline M. Roadt, F/W, 07/01/83 at the Draft. Henrickson contacted her ex-boyfriend, Steven A. Raatz, M/W, 07/28/88, because she was not feeling well and wanted a ride to the hospital.

Raatz arrived at the Draft and Henrickson got into his vehicle. Raatz proceeded to drive WB on W. Lincoln Ave. Henrickson stated Raatz began to yell at her and told her to get out of the vehicle as they crossed over Interstate 894. Raatz also took her cell phone from her.

Henrickson got out of the vehicle and walked back to the Draft. Henrickson informed Roadt about the incident and had her contact Henrickson so he could return her phone to her. Raatz then returned to the Draft and parked on the west side of the building. Henrickson opened the driver side door and took her phone back from Raatz. Henrickson then walked over to her vehicle and got inside of it.

Henrickson stated Raatz then walked up to her vehicle. Henrickson stated she had her window half way down. Raatz then proceeded to yell at Henrickson and call her a "Bitch". Henrickson then rolled her window up briefly before rolling it half way down again. Henrickson stated Raatz then grabbed onto the window and it shattered.

Henrickson stated she and Raatz previously lived together for approximately 9

Henrickson stated at no time did she fear for her safety. Henrickson also informed Officers if she knew Raatz was going to be arrested, she never would have contacted the Police. Henrickson only wanted a report completed so she could get her driver side window fixed.

LACK OF CONSENT

Henrickson did not give Raatz permission to break her driver side window, causing a financial loss.

ARREST DECISION

Based on Henrickson's statement, because Henrickson and Raatz previously lived together and Raatz was the pre-dominant aggressor, Raatz was arrested for Criminal Damage to Property/DV and was transported to the station.

72 HOUR NO CONTACT

On 12/13/13 at approximately 2314 hrs., I read and explained the 72 hour No Contact Provision to Henrickson. Henrickson stated she understood and signed the form.

BOOKING

Raatz was booked, mugged and fingerprinted to Criminal Damage to Property/Domestic Violence.

STATEMENT OF STEVEN A. RAATZ.

Raatz was placed into Interview room B of the Booking room and read his Miranda Rights. Raatz stated he understood his rights and agreed to give a voluntary statement without an attorney present. The interview started at 0102 hrs., and was completed at 0108 hrs. The following is a summary statement of Raatz:

Raatz stated Henrickson contacted him via telephone and told him she needed someone to drive her to the hospital because she was not feeling well. Raatz

arrived at the Draft and picked her up in his vehicle. Raatz stated they proceeded to get into a verbal argument and he took her cell phone away from her. Raatz then kicked Henrickson out of his vehicle. Raatz drove in a circle and told Henrickson to get back into his vehicle. Henrickson refused.

Raatz then returned to the Draft parking lot and observed Henrickson get into her vehicle. Raatz then walked over to Henrickson's vehicle. Henrickson called him a "Psycho". and started rolling up her window. Raatz grabbed onto the window as Henrickson was rolling it up causing the window to break.

WAIVER OF 72 HOUR NO CONTACT ORDER

On 12/14/13 at approximately 0042 hrs., Henrickson came into the station and signed a waiver of the no-contact order.

DV HOTLINE

On 12/15/13 at approximately 0619 hours, I spoke to Africa from the Sojourner Truth House and advised her of this incident.

CASE DISPOSITION

Raatz was able to post bail. He signed the conditional Release and Contact Prohibition Notice and was released at 0114 hrs on 12/14/13. A Milwaukee County DA will review this case on on 12/16/13 at 0830 hrs.

NARRATIVE

Officer Schweitzer reports...

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 12/13/13 at approximately 2314 hrs, I responded to the Draft Bar, 9105 W Lincoln Ave, for a report of Steven Raatz breaking the window on the victims vehicle. Before officers arrived, Steven left the scene.

CONTACT JACQUELINE ROADT

I made contact with the witness, Jacqueline M Roadt, F/W, 07/1/83, Jacqueline stated while she inside the Draft Bar, her friend, Jaymie R Henricksen, F/W, 08/11/92 came back inside the bar after leaving with her ex-boyfriend, Steven Raatz. Jaymie told Jacqueline Steven had broke her driver's side window and then left in a black Ford Mustang with her car keys. Jaymie told Jacqueline that while in the car with Steven, they engaged in a verbal argument and Jaymie advised Steven was calling her a "psycho bitch" multiple times. Once Jaymie told Jacqueline that Steven had broken her vehicle window, Jacqueline went outside and spoke with Steven. Steven stated to Jacqueline that he and Jaymie began arguing while Steven was driving and that Jaymie was yelling at him saying he was a "jackass" and he was "psycho". Jacqueline advised Steven was very angry and she could not talk him down so he and Jaymie would stop arguing. While speaking with Jacqueline I could smell a strong odor of alcohol emitting from her breath.

OFFENDER STATEMENT - STEVEN RAATZ

While still on scene, I observed a black Ford Mustang, pull into the parking lot of the west side of the Draft Bar. Both Jacqueline and Jaymie advised Steven had just arrived. I then spoke with Steven A Raatz, M/W, 07/28/88 about this incident. Steven explained, Jaymie is an ex-girlfriend who he dated for approximately one year. During the year of dating Jaymie and Steven lived together for approximately nine months. Jaymie called Steven tonight and asked him to drive her to the hospital because hey cyst on her head was causing her pain. Once Steven picked up Jaymie they began to argue about past relationship issues. Jaymie began yelling at Steven, saying he was a fucking psycho jackass. Steven became angry and told Jaymie to get out of his vehicle. Before Jaymie exited Steven's vehicle, Jaymie was speaking her parents on her cellphone. Steven took Jaymie's cellphone from her person. I asked Steven if he took her keys from before she left his vehicle. Steven admitted to taking her keys but could not a valid reason why he took her keys. After Jaymie exited the vehicle, Steven went back to the Draft Bar and waited for

Jaymie to return. I asked Steven if he broke her driver's side window. Steven said he did break the window. I asked Steven why he broke the window. Again Steven would not answer the question fully. At this time Steven was placed under arrest for DV/Criminal Damage to Property.
