The proposal by Gerber Leisure Products of Landscape Structures playground equipment was chosen over the other proposals because:

<sup>\*</sup> Landscape Structures was determined to have a higher quality of construction than the others.

<sup>\*</sup>The design by Gerber offers more play equipment then the others, including a wider bridge, more access points, and included a major play piece that the others did not offer, the funnel net climber.

<sup>\*</sup>The design by Gerber also allows enough room for parents to help their children access all play equipment while some of the others did not.

<sup>\*</sup>The post component support system (clamps) was also preferred over the sleeve style support system offered by GameTime, because the clamp design has been determined to provide easier maintenance and allows for design chnages if needed.
