

The WACCC too has been experiencing many equipment problems involving cameras and tape decks, which are affecting the quality of their programs. This issue won't be resolved until the franchise renewal is attained with Time Warner Cable, but the WACCC continues to move along as best they can.

In the area of programming the WACCC produced 55 programs in the fourth quarter and totaling 201 programs for 2006. Among these were former Mayor Frank Ziedler "Remembers Milwaukee", "Milwaukee County District Attorney Candidate Forum", "Weddings of Yesterday Fashion Show", "Billie the Brownie", and the "Santa Call In Show". Four new members joined the WACCC bringing the total for 2006 to 28 new members. 18 people went through the workshops dealing with the studio and field production equipment, editing equipment and producer's classes. And, the Irish Cultural and Heritage Center and the Polish Center of Wisconsin went through training.

Fundraising activities were high on the list of WACCC activities in the fourth quarter. They included a Haunted Television Station Scare-A-Thon, photos with Santa in the WACC lobby, and selling holiday promos to businesses. The WACCC is gearing up for their 25th Anniversary event on March 25, 2007.

I recommend providing 4th quarter funding for the WACCC.
