

NARRATIVE

PO ISKANDARANI REPORTS:

INITIAL INFORMATION:

On 02/04/2015 at approx. 2216hrs, officers responded to Kokopelli's Pub and Grub located at 6001 W Madison St to investigate a report of a male being disorderly and refusing to leave the business. Upon arrival, I assisted officers already on scene by acting as a cover officer for Lt Pye who was speaking with the subject in front of the door leading into the business.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS:

During my initial contact with the subject, later identified as Scott J Braaten, M/W, 05/18/1962, I could tell Scott was highly intoxicated and agitated with police contact. Scott had his left side towards Lt Pye and his back towards me. As I asked Scott to provide his name and information, Scott slowly turned around counter clockwise and started spelling his last name.

Scott speech was heavily slurred and he was speaking softly making it difficult to hear. I asked Scott to repeat the spelling of his last name. Scott started screaming "did I fucking stutter?" tensing his entire body and closing both of his fists. Scott took 2-3 small steps forward toward me.

As a result of Scott's aggressive behavior, his high level of intoxication, his unwillingness to cooperate with officers, Scott was directed to the ground. As Lt. Pye moved in to direct Scott to the ground, I believed Scott was going to assault officers on scene.

RESISTING AN OFFICER:

PO Mussatti, PO Keiley, Lt Pye, and I moved in to try and secure Scott in handcuffs. Officers advised multiple times to "stop resisting" and "put your

hands behind your back". Scott continued to struggle and actively resist officer's attempts to place his hands behind his back. Scott was lying face down on the sidewalk with his hands tensed and locked under his body.

As I tried to bring his right arm out from under his body, he continued to actively struggle and resist. I could feel resistive tension and could tell Scott was not going to willingly bring his hands behind his body. Scott continued display resistive tension in his arms as we tried to bring his right arm out from under his body. Scott arms and hands being under his body prevented officers from being able to place him in handcuffs. Throughout the entire struggle officers were issuing commands to "stop resisting" and to bring his hands behind his back.

While I worked to free Scott's right hand, I observed PO Mussatti directing focused strikes towards his lower left back and abdominal area. Officers were still struggling to place Scott in handcuffs.

Based on my observations and the fact Scott continued to struggle, disregard our commands to stop resisting, and not place his hands behind his body I drew my "Electronic Control Weapon" (ECW) and placed it in the small of his back. I deployed the device causing Scott's body to "lock up".

Immediately after the five (5) seconds was over, Scott stopped actively resisting officers and we were able to place him in handcuffs. No additional force was used as the threat was stopped and Scott was secured in handcuffs.

MEDICAL CLEARANCE:

After placing Scott in handcuff restraints, officers immediately radioed for dispatch to send medical services to our location for an examination. Upon arrival, Scott was physically cooperative and stated he did not require medical attention.

Scott ultimately declined medical treatment from WAFD and stated he did not want to be transported to the hospital.

After concluding the medical screening, I conducted a thorough search of Scott before placing him in the back of my squad vehicle for transport to the station. Located in his right pants pocket, I located a small gray pipe that based on my experience, I believed to be used for smoking marijuana. I confiscated this item and secured him in the back of my squad car.

TRANSPORT:

Scott was transported back to the West Allis Police Department without incident.

MIRANDIZED STATEMENT:

On 02/04/2015 at 2340hrs, while in Interview Room A of the West Allis Police Department, I read Scott his Miranda Warnings off Departmental Directive 42.016. Scott declined to speak with me regarding this incident. This was audio recorded on an Olympus DS-2200 Digital Voice Recorder and saved on a departmental media card (P14-1) and stored in the Technical and Forensics Bureau.

BOOKING:

Scott was arrested, printed, and booked under booking #2015000513 for Resisting an Officer, Disorderly Conduct, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Scott was issued three municipal citations, M150005132, M150005133, and M150005131 with a local court date of 03/16/2015 at 0830hrs. Scott switched from being cooperative to verbally uncooperative throughout the booking process. Scott also refused to sign the PR bonds for the Disorderly Conduct and Resisting an Officer citations.

PROPERTY:

The small gray marijuana pipe was placed on property under property #15-00831-1.

CASE DISPOSITION:

On 02/04/2015 at approx. 2216hrs, officers responded to Kokopelli's Pub and Grub located at 6001 W Madison St to investigate a report of a male being disorderly and not leaving. Upon arrival, officers made contact with Scott J Braaten M/W 05/18/1962 who was ultimately taken into custody for the multiple offenses. After concluding the booking process, responsible party Joseph M Behmke, M/W, 01/01/1961, arrived on scene and took custody of the highly intoxicated offender.

NARRATIVE

Lt Pye Reports 02/04/2015

I responded to this call as I was in the area. I was the first to arrive and entered the bar. I observed the offender, Scott Braaten, seated at the bar. There were approximately 6 other patrons in the bar. The bartender told me that Braaten was beligerent and had been kicked out of the bar numerous times tonite and kept returning and being disorderly. See Officer Mussatti supplement for complete statement of the bartender.

I escorted Braaten outside the bar and asked him what was happening tonite and he stated that "he started shit and doesn't know why". Additional officer arrived at this time. Braaten stated that he did not have any identification on him so I asked him to verbally provide his name. He spelled his last name unintelligably and he was asked to repeat it. He bagan to scream and swear and refused to provide his name. I advised him at this time that he was under arrest for disorderly conduct and grabbed his right arm to turn him away from me. He immediately attempted to pull away from me and face me while swearing at me so I decentralized him onto the sidewalk. Braaten tucked his arms underneath him and would not put his arms behind him as ordered. Officer Iskanderani deployed a Taser drive stun to Braaten's back, see Officer Iskanderani supllement.

Braaten was ultimately secured in handcuffs, medically treated by WAFD and then transported to WAPD for processing.

NARRATIVE

Officer Mussatti reports...

INITIAL ARRIVAL

Upon arriving to Kokopelli's Pub and Grub, I observed several officers out with the male party (Scott Braaten) who had refused to leave the business when asked. While they were talking to Braaten, I entered the business to speak with the bartender, Brian T. Williams, M/W 11/28/73.

BRIEF STATEMENT OF BRIAN T. WILLIAMS - WITNESS

I asked Williams what happened. He said Braaten was being loud and belligerent immediately upon entering the bar. Williams could tell he was drunk, and advised Braaten he could not serve him. Williams ultimately told Braaten to leave the bar, and he left but returned through the back door. After he returned through the back door, Braaten refused to leave, and continued to be disorderly inside the bar.

RESISTING/USE_OF_FORCE

After I received a brief statement from Williams, I started to walk towards the front of the business to advise assisting officers. As I was walking towards the clear glass door, I observed people rolling on the ground, one of which appeared to be an officer. I immediately exited the business, and it appeared the officers were trying to gain control of Braaten while on the ground.

I positioned myself to the left of Braaten, and he was refusing to put his arms behind his back. His arms were by his chest, and I grabbed his left arm. I yelled at Braaten to put his left arm behind his back. While I was holding onto his arm, I felt his arm tense, and he was pulling against me in an

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attempt to keep his arm by his chest. I punched the left side of Braaten's abdomen in attempt to get his arm behind his back. After I struck him, I continued to try to pull his arm back, and at this point, Officer Iskandarani tased Braaten. After Braaten was tased, I was able to pull his arm completely behind his back to complete the handcuffing.

FURTHER STATEMENT OF BRIAN T. WILLIAMS

After Braaten was arrested, I returned inside the bar to obtain a more detailed statement from Williams. Williams observed Braaten walk into the business, and said when he entered, he was immediately loud. Braaten yelled, "Where's the party?" and, "What the fuck?" He said Braaten appeared intoxicated due to him walking in, partly stumbling. Williams said he would not serve him drinks, due to him already being intoxicated. Upon telling Braaten that he would not be served alcohol, Braaten became angry and started to yell at and insult Williams. I asked Williams what Braaten was saying. Braaten called him a delinquent and said he did not know how to do his job, along with other insults.

While Braaten was yelling and insulting Williams, Williams tried to calm him down and asked him to leave. Braaten left the bar, and he immediately returned by entering through the back door of the business. Williams again advised him he had to leave the bar. Braaten continued to yell at Williams, and he refused to leave. Braaten said he was calling the police, opened his phone, and then he closed the phone and said he called the police. Williams advised Braaten he was going to call the police. Williams called the police, and ultimately officers arrived on scene. Williams said there were approx. seven people inside the main area of the bar, and there were several people in the back of the bar. He said most of the customers saw the disturbance Braaten created.
