I was sitting on my butt with my knees up and my hands over my knees out in plain view. Multiple police officers, at least over 5 that I could see, came within one yard of me with their guns drawn. One police officer spoke and said. "Don't move, there are 8 fucking machine guns on you, if you move we'll blow your fucking brains out." I was very scared and didn't even move my eyes because I didn't want to get shot and killed!

No other commands from the police officers to myself were made. A few then rushed me by kicking me in the head. I was NOT resistful, I fell over and closed my eyes and just felt pain starting all over my body. I put my hands behind my back immediately hoping the attack would stop but yet I still felt blows to my body and punches to my head area. To be specific, like I was being stomped on. I was handcuffed and then tazed and during the taze

I was stiff, still feeling more punches and kicks to my body and head. I was yelling ahhh, thats all I could get out of my voice. When the attack was over I almost passed out cause of the crucial pain I was feeling and I seen the puddle of blood from the blood pouring out of my face. They left me lay there for a minute when they were done to catch their breathes. I started crying and asking "why" they did that to me and that I didnt deserve it! Also to please dont hurt me no more.
