**AB582/  
SB335** **ALLOWING PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE SUMMARIES**  
FAVOR, because the bill would allow publication of ordinance summaries rather than the entire ordinance, thus reducing city publication costs.

SB322** **EXEMPTING RESTAURANTS FROM LIQUOR LICENSE QUOTA**


