Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on June 25, 2013, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That Dilneet Corporation, by registered agent, Rupinder Randhawa, was properly served a copy of the summons and complaint, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ar);
2. That Dilneet Corporation failed to pay its 2010, 2011, and 2012 real estate taxes in full.
3. That the conduct of Dilneet Corporation described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.10(1) and West Allis Revised Municipal Ordinance Sections 1.08(9)(a) and 9.02(12)(d).
4. That in particular, Dilneet Corporation's failure to pay its real estate taxes for the tax years of 2010 through 2012 and failing to meet the terms of its payment agreement is contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.10(1) and West Allis Revised Municipal Ordinance Sections 1.08(9)(a) and 9.02(12)(d).

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to revoke and not renew the Class A Beer, Class A Liquor, Cigarette and Tobacco Products licenses and Food-Related Permit of Dilneet Corporation.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Class A Beer, Class A Liquor, Cigarette and Tobacco Products licenses and Food-Related Permit of Dilneet Corporation be revoked and not renewed.
