Revised Resolution for Riley Construction for Remodeling of Fire Station

**Facilities** 

The bid proposal for remodeling the new administration building and Station No. 3 had three parts to it: 1) Labor, 2) Materials and 3) Sales Tax Savings on the materials. By trying to guarantee the sales tax savings (I think it's rather open ended) and trying to get the best price on two very close bids from Riley and Miron, I managed to add the sales tax savings in twice. Even with a number of discussions with the architect on this matter, it's ultimately my fault.

The revised resolution for Riley Construction (they still had the lowest combined bid) corrects the contract amount. It adds \$33,738 to Riley's contract (Sales Tax Savings only once, not twice) and reduces the contingency amount by the same amount. The total amount of \$2,935,800 does change. Even though this reduces the contingency amount, we are still confident it can get done for the total amount of \$2,935,800 originally approved.
